1.Use and publication

1.1. Contribution

The author(s) hereby confirm(s) that he/she/they is/are the sole author(s) of the contribution, that he/she//they is/are entitled to grant the following licenses and that he/she/they has/have so far not transferred any rights which would be in conflict with the licenses under this agreement to third parties.

The author(s) hereby transfer(s) exclusively, free of charge and without restraint to time and place to Mesago Messe Frankfurt GmbH, Stuttgart, the following rights of use to the above referenced contribution:

- the right to publish within the framework of the PCIM Europe conference,
- the right to copy and distribute (publishing right),
- the right for electronic publication including the necessary modifications, the storage on electronic media, the download and the availability in an online data base (right of adaption),
