PCIM Europe Student Travel Grants

The PCIM Europe offers a small number of supplemental travel grants (500€ each) to support international students to attend the conference 2024. The travel grants will be provided to eligible and selected student authors who will present an accepted paper at PCIM Europe Conference 2024.

Important deadlines

- **30 October 2023:** Submission of the abstract. Please upload the below mentioned documents together with your abstract submission to apply for a travel grant.
- **January 2024:** Notification about acceptance of your abstract as well as the Student Travel Grants.

What does this grant cover?

Each grant is intended to partially reimburse travel expenses (airfare, ground transportation, and/or hotel). Meals and the conference registration fee are not eligible for reimbursement.

Who can apply?

To qualify for the travel grant, applicants must be a full-time student at an international university (excluding Germany, Austria and Switzerland) registered toward a Bachelor/Masters/PhD degree related to power electronics. A student who is awarded a travel grant must register, attend the conference in person and present the paper (oral or poster) at PCIM Europe Conference 2024.

How to apply?

An application for the Student Travel Grant must consist of:

- A legitimization of your student status
- The student's resume, including your citizenship
- Information about the availability of funds from other sources

Please upload these documents with your abstract in the upload field on the submission platform.

How are grant recipients reimbursed?

Grant recipients must collect and submit their travel receipts. Payment will only be made to the student as long as the recipient submits the expense report (with original receipts) within 30 days after the conference. Reimbursements will not exceed the total amount of 500€ each.
